The Senate of Prizren University "Ukshin Hoti," within the competencies defined according to the Statute, in accordance with the provisions of Law No. 04/L-037 for higher education in the Republic of Kosovo and Regulation No. 01-05/A of external collaborators at "Ukshin Hoti" University, in the meeting held on 22.9.2023, decided to announce:

CALLING

To engage external collaborators for lectures and exercises based on the academic units' needs at the University "Ukshin Hoti" for the academic year 2023/24.

The engagement with an honorarium of external collaborators for lectures and exercises will be done based on the proposals of academic units, in accordance with Law No. 04/L-037 on higher education in the Republic of Kosovo, the provisions of the University's Statute, and other applicable legislation regarding employment relationships, in conformity with the procedures of Regulation No. 01-05/A for the engagement of external collaborators at the University "Ukshin Hoti".

a) General conditions for engagement:

- I. External academic staff may be engaged at the University for a specified period, with the purpose of conducting educational and scientific activities based on a public callings for external collaborators (with an honorarium). Engagement does not imply the establishment of an employment relationship through this calling, nor automatic payment during the period of engagement.
- II. Candidates who, in addition to their primary contract with full-time employment, also have a secondary commitment to public institutions cannot be engaged at the University "Ukshin Hoti".
- III. The engagement with an honorarium of external collaborators is carried out transparently and in accordance with Regulation No. 01-05/A for the engagement of external collaborators at the University "Ukshin Hoti".

- Application letter
- Biography (CV)
- Birth certificate/Extract
- Criminal record certificate (evidence from the court regarding the criminal history);
- Notarized copy of the relevant diploma issued by the competent authority (candidates who graduated outside the Republic of Kosovo must bring the decision of the nostrified diploma of the relevant level as: Bachelor, Masters, Magistration, and Doctorate)

- Candidates who apply for the assistant, lecturer and corepetitor position, shall also bring the grade certificate of the bachelors and masters studies;
- Evidence of scientific and professional publications, as well as other additional specific information;
- Evidence of University engagement (if engaged before) or other accredited institution of higher education;
- Candidates who are not citizens of the Republic of Kosovo must provide evidence of residence permit. If they are not resident in the Republic of Kosovo, they shall provide an affidavit stating that they are not resident inhabitants of the Republic of Kosovo.
- Evidence for knowledge of foreign languages (Knowledge of English language or any other languages is an advantage).
- *Regular academic staff of the Public Universities in the Republic of Kosovo who are interested in engagement according through this calling in addition to the mentioned documentation above, must also provide an approved request from their employer in accordance with the provisions of Regulation No. 09/2023 on Functional Addition.*
