The Senate of the "Ukshin Hoti" University in Prizren, within the powers defined by the Statute, in accordance with the provisions of Law no. 04/L-037 for higher education in the Republic of Kosovo and Regulation no. 01-05/A for the engagement of external collaborators at "Ukshin Hoti" University, in the meeting held on: 29.7.2024, decided to announce:

Competition

For the engagement of external collaborators for lectures and exercises based on the needs of the academic units of "Ukshin Hoti" University for the academic year 2024/25.

The engagement with honorarium of external collaborators for lectures and exercises will be based on the proposals of the academic units, in accordance with Law no. 04/L-037 for higher education in the Republic of Kosovo, the provisions of the University Statute and other legislation in force on the employment relationship according to the procedure provided in the provisions of Regulation no. 01-05/A for the engagement of external collaborators at the University "Ukshin Hoti" Prizren.

a) General conditions for engagement:

- I. External academic personnel can be engaged at the University for a certain period, in order to carry out educational and scientific activity on the basis of a public competition for external collaborators (with honoraria). Engagement does not mean, according to this competition, the establishment of a working relationship and receiving an academic call, nor automatic payment during the period for which it is committed.
- II. At "Ukshin Hoti" University, candidates who, in addition to the full-time primary contract, also have a secondary commitment in public institutions, cannot be engaged.
- III. The engagement of external collaborators with a fee is done in a transparent manner in accordance with Regulation no. 01-05/A for the engagement of external collaborators at the University "Ukshin Hoti" Prizren.

b) Documentation required for application:

- Request for application;
- Biography (CV);
- Birth certificate/extract;
- Criminal certificate (evidence from the court on the criminal past);
- Copy of the relevant diploma notarized by the competent body, (candidates who have graduated outside the Republic of Kosovo, must also bring the decision of notarization of the relevant diploma such as: bachelor's, master's, magistracy, and doctorate);

- Candidates who apply for the position of assistant, lecturer or tutor, must also bring the certificate of grades of bachelor's and master's studies;
 - Evidence of scientific and professional publications, as well as other specific additional information;
 - Proof of engagements at the University (if they have been engaged before) or at any other (accredited) institution of higher education;
 - Candidates who do not have citizenship of the Republic of Kosovo, must bring proof of residence permit. If they do not have a resident status in the Republic of Kosovo, they must bring an affidavit that they are not resident residents in the Republic of Kosovo.
 - Proof of knowledge of foreign languages (knowledge of English or any other foreign language is an advantage).
- *The documentation must be original or notarized and must be complete for all positions to which the candidate applies, which means that candidates with incomplete files in any position will be automatically disqualified from the selection.*
 - *Public functionaries, public officials, other officials, as well as university academic staff, who express interest in engagement according to this competition in addition to the documentation mentioned above, must strictly implement the provisions of paragraph 4 of article 4 of Government Regulation no. 09/2023 for the Functional Addition (cit: " 4.1. notifies and receives approval from the highest administrative leader of the institution where he is employed with a primary contract (full-time); 4.2. submits to the institution where he will perform the additional commitment the certificate of the basic salary of the position where he is employed with a primary contract (full-time) ".*
For the regular academic staff in one of the public universities, approval is given by the head of the institution, in accordance with internal legal acts.
