CONDITIONS:

Please note that you are required to be proficient in English or German at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

If you are selected to participate in the Erasmus+ program as an exchange student, you will receive a grant that assures the payment of the living costs in Germany (850,00€ - 1.100,00€/ month). Each selected participant will also get a travel contribution of 275,00€. The winter term 2025/26 starts on **September 22nd, 2025 and ends on February 20th, 2026**. It is expected of all students to arrive at least a week before the start of the term.

APPLICATION:

If you wish to participate in the Erasmus+ exchange, first you need to apply directly at the International Relations Office at University of Pristina. In case you are selected and pre-nominated by your home university, you will receive further information about the application process from HNEE. Make sure you apply with the following documents:

- **Motivational letter** for the chosen study programme
- **Current enrolment certificate** from your home university with a current date!
- **Transcript of records**
- **Language certificate** must comply with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)

An application only has a chance to be successful if all documents are submitted together and completed in full.. Otherwise, your application cannot be taken into consideration.
